Call to Worship

Leader: Clap your hands, all you nations; shout to God with

cries of joy.

People: For the Lord Most High is awesome, the great

King over all the earth.

Leader: God has ascended amid shouts of joy, the Lord amid

the sounding of trumpets.

People: Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has

ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us

hold firmly to the faith we profess.

Leader: For we do not have a high priest who is unable to

empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—

yet he did not sin.

People: Let us then approach God's throne of grace with

confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find

grace to help us in our time of need.

Leader: Sing praises to God, sing praises;

People: Sing praises to our King, sing praises.

Confession of Sin

Leader: The LORD takes pleasure in his people; he adorns the

humble with salvation. Humble yourselves before the

Lord, and he will lift you up.

People: If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and

the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is

faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse

us from all unrighteousness.

(silent confession of sin)

Assurance of God's Forgiveness

Leader: By grace you have been saved through faith. And this

is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result

of works, so that no one may boast.

People: I am confident of this, that he who began a good

work in you will bring it to completion at the day of

Jesus Christ.

Profession of Faith

Leader: The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full

acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to

save sinners

People: For there is one God, and there is one mediator

between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who

gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the

testimony given at the proper time.

Leader: Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness:

People: He was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the

Spirit, seen by angels, proclaimed among the

nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.
