

## **Growth Group Discussion Guide**

Passage: Isaiah 7:10-14

Sermon: God With Us To Save Us Sermon Series: Prepare Him Room

Introduction: In this passage King Ahaz was facing a military threat and was tempted to look to the nation of Assyria for help. God warned Ahaz of this snare and promised to protect Ahaz if he would only trust Him. To confirm this promise, God offered Ahaz a sign but Ahaz rejected this offer. However, God did not reject His people and gave them a sign Himself. A baby would be born of a virgin and his name would be called Immanuel. Ultimately this promise was fulfilled in birth of Jesus Christ. Through Jesus God is with us to save us even in the midst of our most trying times.

How is God's promise ultimately confirmed through Jesus? Consider: Matthew 1:18-25, Matthew 28:18-20, John 14:15-18




## Into the Heart
