Passage: Psalm 78:1-8 Sermon: Raising a Righteous Generation Sermon Series: The Generation of the Righteous

Introduction: This past month we have been looking at what it means that "God is with the generation of the righteous". In this passage the psalmist Asaph shows us how God's people are called and equipped to raise a righteous generation by cultivating Gospel centered lives.



Into the Word

"If we are going to raise a righteous generation then the Gospel must be front and center."

How does this passage describe the relationship between God's grace and God's law in the lives of His people? Does the order matter? Consider: Exodus 20:2

Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9. What can we learn here about cultivating a gospel culture?



Into the Heart

"The greatest danger to raising a righteous generation is self-righteousness."

How does our experience of God's grace and law affect the way we approach the next generation? Consider: Psalm 145:21

How can we guard against self-righteousness as we raise the next generation?



What are ways we can intentionally cultivate a gospel culture in our home? Note: Time, moments, milestones.

What resources have helped you keep the Gospel at the center of your home?

What does it look like to model a commitment to a gospel community?
